### Ecological Understanding of Risks of the Environment through a deeper Knowledge and Awareness: EUREKA

The indicator for early leavers from education and training is defined as the percentage of the population aged 18-24 with at most a lower secondary education and who were not in further (formal or nonformal) education or training during the four weeks preceding the survey.

"Four Countries Four Associations Four High Schools come together for EUREKA." **EUREKA**, aims to intervene in this issue by promoting innovative and digital educational methods and the development of new training courses that foster the attractivenesses of the school environment and its key-role for a much more smart and inclusive society.

The project also cross-cuts and joins other EU 2020 strategies, such as those desling with climate change effect and unemployment.



#### 1<sup>st</sup> Transnational MEETING

EUREKA project's kick-off transnational meeting took place in Forcalquier (France) on December the 9th and 10th of 2019.

The objectives of this meeting were to allow the partners to meet each other, share tasks and present their respective methods. Notably, the partners elaborated a common methodology for the production of EUREKA project's three main predicted results:

- Output 1: Development of an interactive education and data haring platform with a virtual community tool,
- Output 2: Production of "GAP analysis report" supposed to allow the partners to understand the comprehension gap that need to be filled in order to attain the project's objectives, especially regarding climate change, early school leaving, unemployment or science related pedagogy and digital tools,
- Output 3: Production of Good Practices Handbook summarizing the project's objectives, methodologies and results and describing the experimentation conducted by the partnership for its potential reproduction elsewhere in the EU.
